School Block Challenge 2017 *Fabric Packet Form*

Students in grades K-12 throughout the United States are invited to enter this annual contest, which challenges their creativity with fabric. Moda generously provides the 3 challenge fabrics in each packet for the contest. Materials are limited; therefore entry packets will be distributed as requests are received. A \$3.00 fee per packet is requested for all mailed packets to help cover postage. Cash awards will be given to the winning contestants. All blocks will be exhibited at the National Quilt Museum in early 2017 for you & our visitors to enjoy.

Notes:

- ❖ Teachers may receive a maximum of 10 packets.
- ❖ Each block must include a recognizable piece of each challenge fabric; 1 packet can be used for multiple blocks.
- ❖ Teachers may submit multiple entries, up to the number of students in the class.
- ❖ Blocks are constructed by individual students, by small groups, or by an entire class collectively.
- ❖ A student may only participate in one block.
- ❖ Students must be affiliated with a School or group, such as Girl or Boy Scouts, Youth Group, Boys & Girls Club, Home-School, 4-H, etc. Cash awards are presented to the sponsoring organization.
